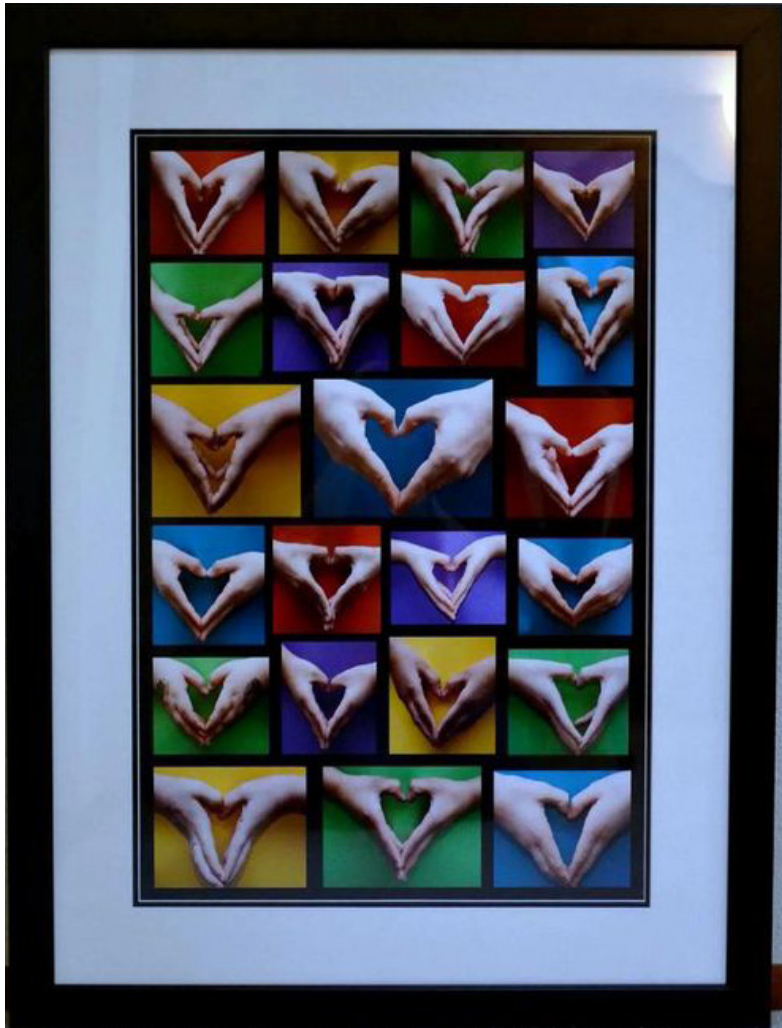

- + Please complete by April 1st

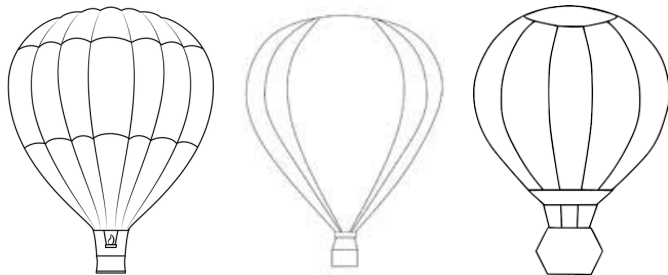

- ** Please feel free to use something other than hot air balloons. Anything else that you think will be graphic and colorful and fun for the kiddos to make their own is wonderful!

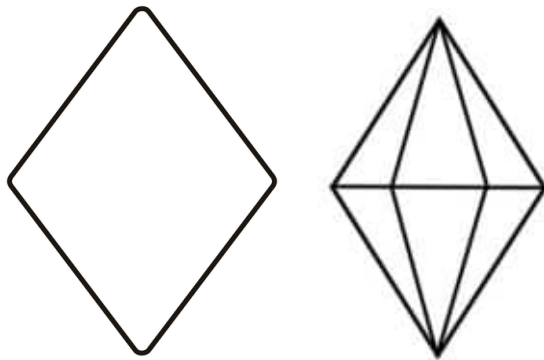

- + Parent to layout overall design/picture and draw outline on paper squares so students know if there are areas where color or black and white drawings are located
- + Students to color and draw on paper squares
- + Parents and/or Students to arrange and mount individual squares into overall design on larger piece of paper or board to be framed
- + Please complete by April 1st
- ** Please feel free to use a different design other than hands making a heart shape. Anything colorful and fun for the kiddos to make

Art Inspiration

— Self Portrait Art

Possible Supplies Needed:

- + Markers or colored pencils
- + 3x3 or 4x4 paper squares
- + Scissors
- + Larger piece paper or mounting board

Instructions:

- + Students to color self portraits of their faces on 3"x3" or 4"x4" squares (ideal if squares are filled with color including background)
- + Once portraits are complete parents and/or students to cut portraits into 4 equal parts
- + Mix up faces and re-group into new groupings of four. Mount on larger piece of paper or board to be framed
- + Please complete by April 1st
